













General Parking: Queen Mary parking operations are separate from XDL and not under our control. Queen Mary will charge for parking at normal rates on Friday. You must pull a ticket upon entry and pay at the exit booth. Bikes entering on Friday are free per the regular Queen Mary policy. That is because bikes generally do not contain enough metal to activate the entry gate sensors and the ticket machines do not function. If you are on a bike, simply pull around the entry gate. Saturday the parking charge is a flat rate of \$10 per car and \$5 per bike. Fees will be collected upon entry from EVERY vehicle entering the facility, except those displaying an official XDL parking pass.

Vendor Information

Check-In: Before setting up inside the venue, please check in at XDL HQ. There you will receive:

- Tickets
- Early entry wristband (to access venue before 11:30 on Saturday, March 22)
- Parking pass (if requested)
- Space assignment

Move-In/Out Procedure: Move in takes place Friday March 21 from 10:00 to 18:00. Please set up tents and other structures during that time. There will be no gate control on Friday so you are free to come and go during set up hours. Overnight security will be present Friday night 18:00 to Saturday morning 7:30. Gates will be locked during that time and you will not have access to the venue. Move out is allowed once the event concludes. The scheduled finish time is 18:00, Saturday, March 22.

Power: XDL is set up in the parking lot of the Queen Mary and there is no power source available. Should you need power, you need to supply your own generator. All generators need to be grounded with a wood block and have a 60 BC fire extinguisher placed next to it.

Insurance: All companies displaying at XDL must provide us with a certificate of insurance in the amount of \$1m that lists the entities below as additional insured.

Obtaining a certificate of insurance is easy. Simply call your insurance carrier and ask them for a certificate. They will ask you for the list of additional insured and a fax number or mailing address. There is no charge and it usually only takes a day to complete. If your company does not have

Business License: The City of Long Beach requires that all companies selling product at XDL have a business license issued by the city of Long Beach. The cost is approximately \$42. We are told the city will send a representative to check for licenses. We have no reason to doubt them because they do so at all Queen Mary events. To obtain a license, please contact:

Tent Permit: Standard rental tents must be accompanied by a tent permit that shows the tent is made of fire retardant material or the manufacturer label stating the same. Vendors in high traffic areas, selling or cooking with their own tents such as E-Z Ups must have the manufacturer label stating that the tent is made of fire retardant material visible, or be able to supply it, or have a fire extinguisher in the booth. Participants with motor homes or trailers that have retractable awnings need to do the same. For more information regarding tent permits please contact:
